## Notice of Motion for Consideration

At the 2020 Mid-Winter Meeting of the Junior Sailing Association of Long Island Sound, Member Program delegates will be asked to vote on the following motion:

Amend Section 11 of the Bylaws to read as follows:

### 11. DUES

The annual dues shall be as follows:

- A. Regular Member and Provisional Member Program Fees
  - a. Up to 60 Sailing Members \$300
  - b. 61 + Sailing Members \$400
  - c. Family Membership
    - i. Family with One Sailor: \$75
    - ii. Family with Two Sailors: \$100
    - iii. Family with Three or More Sailors: \$125
  - d. Junior Sailor Membership (included in Family Membership)
  - e. Instructor Member \$15
  
- B. Special Member Program Fees
  - a. Every registered Junior Sailor \$1 (\$300 minimum)
  - c. Family Membership
    - i. Family with One Sailor: \$75
    - ii. Family with Two Sailors: \$100
    - iii. Family with Three or More Sailors: \$125
  - d. Junior Sailor Membership (included in Family Membership)
  - e. Instructor Member \$15
