YOUNG AMERICAN SAILING ACADEMY (YASA)

Enhancing Junior Big Boat Sailing for Western LIS

An open invitation is extended to Western LIS junior sailors to join YASA and for clubs/organizations to take advantage of the YASA opportunities to complement their own programs. Juniors are encouraged to participate in both YASA and club-based JBBS. This is an opportune time for our sailing community to pool resources so our youth can sail farther.

YASA enhances club-based programs by providing juniors with expanded exposure to big boats and venue selection with a season that runs from early spring to late fall. YASA provides a high level of coaching, utilizing coaches who have extensive local, national and international experience. YASA juniors establish life-long sailing skills, broaden social/leadership skills, and master high-level racing skills.

YASA's program is divided into two levels:

- Level 100 is the on-ramping to big boats with access to two J/105s, sailing primarily day races and short distance races, such as AYC Spring and Fall Series, Larchmont Race Week, Stratford Shoal races, AYC Sunset Series, Stamford YC Breakwater Irregulars, etc.
- Level 200 is for older, more advanced juniors and focuses on longer distance races such as Block Island Race, Around Long Island Regatta, Vineyard Race, etc.

US Sailing REACH Educator Training Course

The Reach Program utilizes sailing as a STEM educational platform.

The course is scheduled for June 12, 2019, at American Yacht Club, Rye NY. It's a one-day eight hour professional development/training opportunity for teachers and sailing instructors to learn how to implement US Sailing's STEM program and curriculum called Reach. The Reach modules feature inquiry-based learning and engineering by design processes to provide youth with hands-on, integrated learning opportunities that inspire interest in fields of study including physics, marine biology, robotics, technology and more.

The Reach modules include on the water and classroom-based activities, for easy implementation in multiple settings: your classroom, sailing center, yacht club, summer camp, or after school program. Flexible, the STEM education curriculum can be implemented in a 40-minute lesson, half day workshops or seasonal program.

The STEM Educator Course is \$150 and includes an 8 hour training, materials, and a personal copy of the 132 page Reach Educator Guide for Middle School Modules 1-10 (retail \$59.95) and a Student Logbook (retail \$8). Upon completion all attendees will receive a US Sailing STEM Educator Course certificate and professional educators will receive a certificate for professional development hours.
