DIRECTIONS TO THE BEACH POINT CLUB, 900 Rushmore Avenue, Mamaroneck, NY 914-698-1600

From the NORTH, take I-95 South to the Mamaroneck Avenue/Mamaroneck Exit. (Exit 18A, second turnoff.) Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Follow Mamaroneck Avenue through the Village of Mamaroneck to the Boston Post Road (Route 1). Turn right onto the Boston Post Road. At the second light turn LEFT onto Orienta Avenue. The road forks immediately, bear left onto Rushmore Avenue. The Club is on the left just after the STOP sign.

From the SOUTH, take I-95 North to Fenimore Road (Exit 18A). Turn RIGHT on Fenimore Road and continue to the end. Turn RIGHT onto the Boston Post Road, Route 1. At the next light turn LEFT onto Orienta Avenue. Road forks immediately, bear left onto Rushmore Avenue. The Club is on the left just after the STOP sign.
