As we head into registration season, we wanted to offer additional information on what to expect in terms of class placement and boat options for your Opti sailor(s).

Following registration PYC will group students based on parent request and instructor input. After the Novice year, the Opti program basically breaks down into two broad groups, each with its own commitment in terms of time and boating equipment:

Classes:	 1) Opti Racing (8 weeks) 2) Opti Intermediate 		
Boat Type:	Optimist		
Class 1 Description:	The Opti Racing class is geared for sailors wanting to participate in the full compliment of Long Island Sound regattas (see schedule below). As such this class will focus on developing racing skills. The age group is typically 11 to 12. The 13 to 15 year age group may continue to compete in Optis in what's known as the Red Fleet, or move up to a double handed boat known as the Pixel.		
Class 2 Description:	The Opti Intermediate class is geared for returning 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} year optimist sailors. This class emphasizes basic competency over racing skills. Participation at regattas is the exception, not the rule, but certainly an available option. The age group is typically 10-11.		
Boat Description:	The Optimist is JSA's designated learn-to-sail / learn-to-race training boat. The optimist is the biggest dinghy class in the world. It is sailed by 150,000 kids in over 100 countries.		
	At 7'7" in length and 77lbs, the Optimist is easily transportable via car top rack or inside any large SUV.		
	Sailors weighing more than 110lbs will have difficulty being competitive in the prevailing light winds of Long Island Sound and should consider stepping up to a bigger boat.		
Rent vs. Own:	A new Optimist is priced at approximately \$3,700 including sails and dolly. A used Optimist can range between \$1,500 and \$3,000 depending on age and condition. The Boat Locker hosts an annual "Opti swap" at which several dozen used boats are sold off by private owners (see dates below).		

	Chartering from the Club or a private owner at PYC is another popular option. Club boats are unavailable to take to regattas, however.
	Most sailors will stay in the Optimist class for about 4 years. An investment in a good hull and then upgrading sails and spars as needed is the most flexible approach.
	Most boat builders have a basic line ("club racer") and an advanced line ("pro racer") of hulls. There are different grades of sails and spars as well. To be competitive at regattas your sailor should have one practice set and one racing set of sails and spars.
